WHEREAS, on November 18, 2021 the RM Office received harassing and abusive phone calls from a new resident to the RM, which resulted in staff filing a report with RCMP.

BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to the Third Party Harassment Policy GG-022, effective immediately [REDACTED], residing on PT NE 08-45-22-W2M, shall not be permitted to receive RM custom work, including the supply of materials such as gravel or culverts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the landowner of this property shall not be permitted to receive RM custom work on this property, while Evan Lindal is residing there.

AND, that in this instance a letter shall not be issued to Evan Lindal advising him of this action.

*Employment Contracts*

**362/21 Bacon**

WHEREAS, *The Municipalities Act* was recently amended with the addition of Section 111(3), which assigns the power to hire, suspend and fire all municipal employees to the Administrator, unless otherwise indicated by Council.

WHEREAS, the historical process for hiring, suspending and firing is done by Council at the recommendation of the Administrator and the Foreman – for the staff of which they are directly responsible.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the power to hire and fire municipal employees, as given to the Administrator by Section 111(3) of *The Municipalities Act, 2020* be rescinded and shall be assigned to the Council under the recommendation of the Administrator and Foreman.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the power to suspend municipal employees shall be assigned to the Administrator for admin staff, to the Foreman for outside staff and that the Council shall be advised of any suspensions at the following Regular Meeting.
