WHEREAS, McGill's Industrial Services Inc. has been laying Calcium Chloride for dust control measures within the R.M. since 2016 and has advised that their 2020 rates remain unchanged from 2019 at a cost of \$0.66/m².

BE IT RESOLVED, that Council order a total of 43,353m² of Calcium Chloride from McGill's Industrial Services Inc. for dust control measures to be supplied as follows:
