Declaration of State of Local Emergency

127/26 Markling

WHEREAS the Rural Municipality of Invergordon No. 430 has experienced substantial impacts due to spring runoff, resulting in water overtopping and flowing across more than twenty (20) municipal roadways, causing damage to infrastructure and creating hazardous conditions;

WHEREAS further adverse conditions are anticipated due to an ongoing significant snowfall event, which is expected to compound flooding, access limitations, and infrastructure damage;

BE IT RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 20 of *The Emergency Planning Act*, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Invergordon No. 430 hereby declares that a State of Local Emergency exists within the municipality, effective as of April 24, 2026;

Declaration of State of Local Emergency (cont'd)

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this State of Local Emergency shall remain in effect until rescinded by resolution of Council or until it expires in accordance with the provisions of *The Emergency Planning Act*.
